


49th Annual *Lake George Boat Show*August 25-26, 2023



Join us for a weekend filled with fun events for the entire family at this non-judged, casual event. New this year on Friday morning we are expanding the weekend activities with two pre-show events on the waters and shores of both Bolton Landing and Hague! This is now a regional event on Friday allowing our members from all locations on the Lake to participate.





Saturday's main show at the Lake George Village docks will include 50+ boats, numerous vendors, antique Model T and Triumph sports cars. Exhibitors will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite boats in several categories and the viewing public will once again select the People's Choice Award.

Weekend Event Schedule

Friday

9 AM-Noon Bring your boat by water or trailer for a casual public viewing at...

Bolton Landing docks at Rogers Memorial Park or ...

Hague Park & boat ramp and docks on Rt. 9N

3-5PM Bring your trailered boat down to the blocked off lane of Beach Road along the Lake George Village docks for a mini land display

5PM – 8 PM Welcome cocktail / hors d' oeuvres gathering at the beautiful Fort William Henry Hotel. Come and catch up on old friendships and start new ones



Saturday

7AM – 9:30AM Exhibitors arrive and are guided to their assigned slip by our seasoned dock crew. Captains pick up their show packet, including a member gift at the registration tent. **10AM – 4 PM** Spectators arrive to our 49th Annual Main Event at the Lake George Village Docks on Beach Rd. Children get free boat rides in our Adironduck.

3:15-4:00PM Spectators look forward to hearing the rumbling start of the boat engines and watching them take off from the docks before circling back to the crowd. Accompanying the boats will be our knowledgeable announcer explaining a brief description of each participating vessel as it passes before the crowd

4:30-6:30PM Conclude the weekend at the Fort William Henry Hotel, walking distance across Beach Rd from the docks, for a casual Awards dinner. Relax and rejuvenate yourself while your boats are being tended by a watchman. The dinner concludes at **6:30PM**, leaving plenty of time to trailer/motor home.

Registration:

Registrations will be honored in the order received, so be sure to submit your registration materials as soon as possible. In the unlikely event that the Show must be delayed or canceled, refunds will be made in full. Registration forms are mailed and emailed to members as well as available to print on our website. Please return by mail no later than August 13th. The Adirondack chapter continues to support the guidelines presented by ABCS International regarding the "Best Preserved" and "Best Restored" categories. The general criteria are traditional boats containing less than 65% of their original hull side and deck planks should be considered as "restored" rather than "preserved". Bottom replacement is a safety item and should not be factored into the preserved/restored estimate. ~ If registering as a Vendor, it is required by the Village of Lake George to obtain a permit from them. Go to Village of Lake George homepage and search vendor application. Please include your check, permit and tax ID# on our registration form. The fee is \$50.

Launching sites:

All trailered boats being launched in Lake George must undergo an inspection at one of the seven regional inspection stations around the lake before launching. This is to ensure that there are no invasive species being introduced to Lake George by trailers or boats. All boats should be clean, drained and dry for free inspection by attending technicians. Refer to Igboatinspections.com for complete information and launch sites.

Million Dollar Beach ramp: Located on Beach Road in Lake George village, just east of the Show docks. If you would like to use this launch, it's best to arrive early, as there are only 25 spaces for trailer parking. Go to Lake George docks and boat launch for full information.

Dunham's Bay Marina: On the east side, 4.3 miles north on 9L. This site is for small boats only – 22 feet or less with low windshields, as there is a fixed bridge you need to go under to get to the lake. dunhamsbaymarina.com Phone: (518)744-2627 or (518)798-1718

Norowal Marina: On the west side, 11.3 miles north on 9N in Bolton Landing. Full-service marina. norowalmarina.com Phone: (518) 644-3741

If you trailer your boat to Lake George, please remember to purchase a Lake Use Permit. These are available at any Marina.

Docking Information: This Show sells out and registrations will be assigned slips in the order they are postmarked. After the docks are full, we will assign slips stern-in to the boardwalk on a line. These boats have great visibility but are more difficult to board. The week of the event, you will receive an email of the docking layout so you will know where your slip is reserved. Remember to bring plenty of fenders and lines. Please arrive between 8:00 – 9:30 am and be in place by 9:45 AM. We will have experienced dock hands to assist you in locating your slip as well as securing your boat. Upon tying up your boat, make your way to the registration tent located at the center of the docking area and enjoy complimentary coffee and pastries. You will also check in here and receive your registration bag. This will contain name tags for registered crew members, gifts, as well as your boat placard to be displayed. If you choose to be in the Fly-by parade, there will be a captains meeting at 3:00PM.. Be sure to browse our ship's store as there are many new items!

***AGAIN, THIS YEAR! ***The Fort William Henry Hotel and Conference Center across from Beach Road from the show are a sponsor. They have set aside a block of rooms for our event at a substantial discount and will also allow our members staying there adequate parking for boat trailers. 
