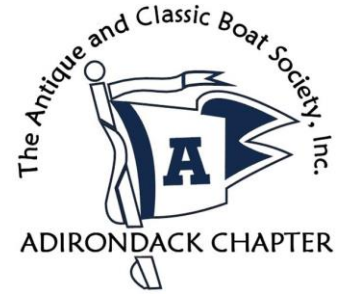




# 31st Annual *Fulton Chain Rendezvous* July 7-9, 2023



Join us for a relaxed weekend with old boats and friends old and new in Old Forge, NY. The Fulton Chain Rendezvous is a non-judged boat show, focused instead on bringing boats and families together for fun on the beautiful waters of the Fulton Chain of Lakes. This year we've added a Sunday brunch cruise on gorgeous Raquette Lake.

Exhibitors will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite boats in several categories including *Historic, Antique, Classic, Contemporary, Outboard, Land Display and Exhibitor's Choice*. A *Most Original/Best Preserved* award will be given to recognize an outstanding craft that has been kept as original as possible. There will also be a *Chris-Craft Stewardship* award and the viewing public will cast their votes for the *People's Choice Award*.

## Weekend Event Schedule

### Friday

**12 Noon to 4 PM**– Lake cruise from Old Forge village docks to Inlet with stop at Northern Lights ice cream (weather permitting).



**6 PM – 8 PM** Welcome reception on the deck at the Forge Motel with heavy hors d'oeuvres and refreshments.

### Saturday

**7 AM – 9 AM** Boat launching at Rivett's Marina.

**9AM- 10AM** Boats tie up at Old Forge Town Docks. Dockmaster will assist with placement.



**10 AM – 2 PM** Public viewing. Free boat rides on Old Forge Pond courtesy of Dunn's Boat Service on Big Moose Lake and the *Adirondack* children's boat. Food concession by Old Forge American Legion, land displays and Adirondack Chapter Ship's Store and Membership tent, plus other land displays.



**2 PM** Boats depart for the parade up the First Lake Channel. Cruising along the Fulton Chain after the Channel is on your own.

**5 PM** Cocktails – **6 PM** Dinner and awards at the Thendara Golf Club, Fifth Street, Thendara. (just outside the Old Forge Village off NYS Route 28)



## Sunday

**11:30 AM** Boarding for Sunday brunch cruise on Raquette Lake aboard the *WW Durant*.

**12:30 PM** Boat departs for 90-minute, narrated historic cruise.

## Boat Launching and Parking

Please make certain that your vessel is clean of invasive marine hitchhikers which includes invasive weed species, zebra mussels, etc. There is wash station located at Rocky Mountain Trailhead (State Route 28 Pull-off) this is a voluntary and free service. <https://www.adkwatershed.org/boat-wash-stations> for more information.

The Town of Webb has reserved boat docking at the village docks for Boat Show participants. Town also has free boat trailer parking at the North Street lot, adjacent to the George T. Hildebrandt Recreation Center, 201 North St, Old Forge.

There are two main choices for launching.

**Rivett's Marina** – Rivett's is on Old Forge Pond and is offering free launching and retrieving for Boat Show participants. You cannot leave your trailer there.

**Inlet Public launch** – located on Route 28 in Inlet. This is a free launch maintained by the NYS DEC. There is very limited parking for trailers. Longer boats may find this an easier launch to use, but space for trailers fills quickly on weekends. Student volunteers from Paul Smith's college may be there to ask about where you are coming from and if your boat is free of invasive plants and marine organisms.

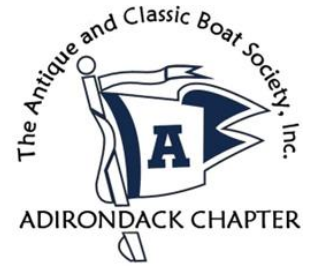
