## Antique & Classic Boat Rendezvous



### August 21-22, 2026

Join us for a weekend filled with fun events for the entire family at this non-judged, casual event. Continuing this year on Friday morning we are having weekend activities with two pre-show events on the waters and shores of both Bolton Landing and Hague! This is now a regional event on Friday allowing our members from all locations on the Lake to participate.

Saturday's main show at the Lake George Village docks will include 50+ boats, numerous vendors & antique Model T cars. Exhibitors will have the opportunity to vote for their favorite boats in several categories, and the viewing public will once again select the People's Choice Award.

## Weekend Event Schedule

### Friday

**9am – Noon** Bring your boat by water or trailer for a casual public viewing at Bolton Landing docks at Rogers Memorial Park or at Hague Town Beach Park & boat ramp on Rt. 9N.

**12:30 – 2:30pm** Informal gathering at the Algonquin Restaurant (weather permitting).

**5 – 7pm** Welcome cocktail & hors d'oeuvres gathering at historic and picturesque Hall's Boat at 9 Front St. in Lake George.



# Weekend Event Schedule (cont.)

## Saturday

**8 – 9am** Exhibitors arrive and are guided to their assigned slip by our seasoned dock crew. Captains pick up their show packet, including a member gift at the registration tent.

**10am – 3pm** Spectators arrive to our 52<sup>st</sup> Annual Main Event at the Lake George Village Docks on Beach Rd.

Children may also receive free boat rides in our “Adironduck” boat, weather permitting.

**3:15 – 4pm** Spectators look forward to hearing the rumbling start of the boat engines and watching them take off from the docks before circling back to the crowd. Accompanying the boats will be our knowledgeable announcer, explaining a brief description of each participating vessel as it passes before the crowd.

**4:30 – 7pm** At the Fort William Henry Hotel, walking distance across Beach Rd from the docks, a casual Awards dinner.

## Registration

Registrations will be honored in the order received, so be sure to submit your registration materials as soon as possible. Registration forms are also available to print on our website. Please return your registration by mail or email no later than August 10<sup>th</sup>, as registration will close on that date.

NOTE: If you are registering as a **Vendor**, the Village of Lake George requires a permit. Go to the [Special Events page](#) at the Village of Lake George website at [lgvillage.org](http://lgvillage.org). Or [click here to view/download the vendor application](#) pdf. The fee is \$50. After you apply, please include a copy of your permit and tax ID# on our boat show registration form.

## Launching Sites

All trailered boats being launched in Lake George must undergo an inspection at one of the seven regional inspection stations around the lake before launching. This is to ensure that there are no invasive species being introduced to Lake George by trailers or boats. All boats should be clean, drained and dry for a free inspection. Go to the [Lake George Park Commission website](#) for complete information and launch sites.

**Million Dollar Beach Ramp:** Located on Beach Road in Lake George village, just east of the Show docks. If you would like to use this launch, it’s best to arrive early, as there are only 25 spaces for trailer parking. Go to the Lake George docks and boat launch for full information.

**Dunham's Bay Marina:** On the east side, 4.3 miles north on 9L. This site is for small boats only – 22 feet or less with low windshields, as there is a fixed bridge you need to go under to get to the lake. [dunhamsbaymarina.com](http://dunhamsbaymarina.com) Phone: (518)744-2627 or (518)798-1718

**Norowal Marina:** On the west side, 11.3 miles north on 9N in Bolton Landing. Full- service marina. [norowalmarina.com](http://norowalmarina.com) Phone: (518) 644-3741

## Docking Information

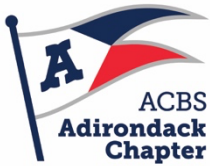
This Show sells out and registrations will be assigned slips in the order they are postmarked. After the docks are full, we will assign slips stern-in to the boardwalk on a line. These boats have great visibility but are more difficult to board. Remember to bring plenty of fenders and lines. Please arrive between 8:00 – 9:00 am. We will have experienced dock hands to assist you in locating your slip. Upon tying up your boat, make your way to the registration tent located at the center of the docking area and enjoy complimentary coffee and pastries. You will also check in here and receive your registration bag. This will contain name tags for registered crew members, gifts, as well as your boat placard to be displayed. If you choose to be in the Fly-by parade, there will be a captains meeting at 3:00PM.

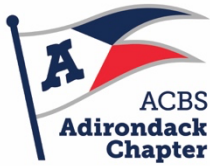
